Hainesport Township School District would like to take this opportunity to provide an update regarding remote learning upon the district's return from winter break. As a reminder, the district is closed for winter break beginning, Thursday, December 24 through Friday, January 1, with instruction resuming on Monday, January 4.

Hainesport Township School District Administration continues to maintain daily communication with the Burlington County Health Department (BCHD), who continues to provide up-to-date COVID-19 data and information as it relates to our community and school. Due to recent upticks in the community and region, as well as the length of winter break which includes multiple major holiday celebrations, the BCHD has advised our school district to remain in full remote status through Friday, January 15. The ten additional days of remote instruction will allow time to mitigate potential exposure that is bound to arise from winter break and holiday celebrations.

In-person instruction will resume the week of January 18, 2021. The district is closed on Monday, January 18 for Martin Luther King Jr. Day, and the return to our regular hybrid schedule has been adjusted accordingly.
