What's Up in K-5th Grade?

The social emotional theme for our Kindergarten - 5th grade students in March is *responsibility!* The School Counselors led classroom lessons during the first 2 weeks of March. During this lesson, students were provided the opportunity discuss the importance of self-discipline during distance learning. As a class, students talked about how to manage their time wisely, how they can use self-discipline & self-control in school, and how to be responsible students.

During a separate lesson with their teachers, students were able to complete a project on responsibility. Students were able to identify their responsibilities before and after distance learning started. Students were able to analyze what was different before distance learning started, what has stayed the same, etc. Students were able to ponder what is a tough new responsibility they have due to distance/hybrid learning.




